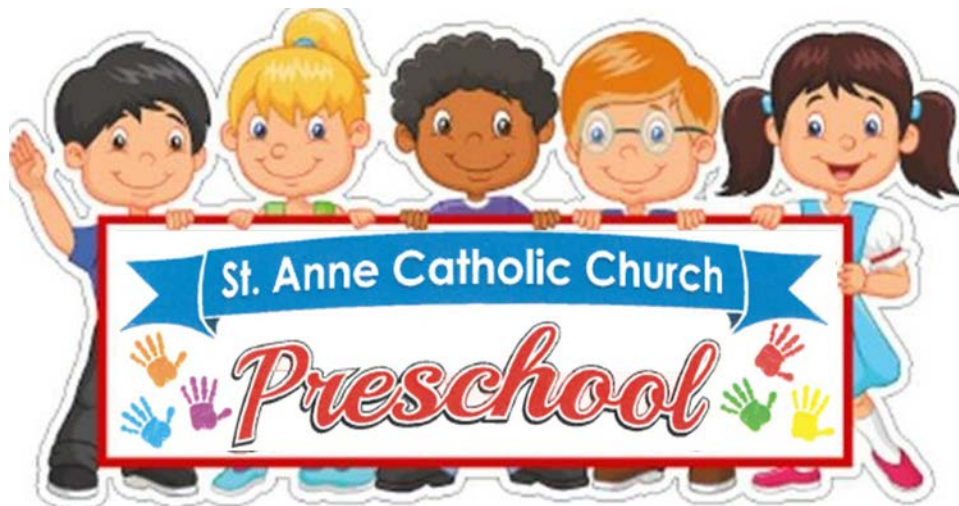

Our preschool program is a unique program in many ways. It is specifically planned for children two, three, and four years of age as they learn through creative, hands-on activities. Our three and four year olds work to grow a relationship with God through the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd program. We foster social skills and independence in small class sizes.

Please bring all school supplies at this time.

The school year will begin August 20 and will be held **9:00 am - 2:00 pm on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays**. All children need to be in attendance in their classroom before 9:00 AM.

We believe that each child is very special and should be treated as such. Each child's total development includes spiritual, academic, emotional, social, & physical growth. We believe that a child should be provided an opportunity to develop in each of these areas at his/her own pace. We offer a positive atmosphere full of love, nurturing, and security. The trust extended to us by parents is never taken lightly. To ensure your child grows in all areas we will form a "team" of three; the child, the parents, and the preschool staff. We will constantly strive to make this a pleasant, enjoyable, and positive experience for you and your child.

Our program is designed to give each child a loving Catholic environment in which to grow and learn about God's world around him/her through art, music, and play. In art we will grow their creativity by working with paints, play dough, crayons and a variety of other materials. Our activities will be adapted to the age capabilities of each child. All areas of social interaction offer each child the opportunity to learn how to share, take turns, and play respectfully with other children.

The three- and four-year-old classes are given the opportunity to engage in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. This is a Montessori based Catholic faith formation program designed for children to grow closer to God through hands-on activities and contemplation.

Academically, we challenge our children with the Experience Curriculum combined with tools, activities, and resources proven successful over many years. Our curriculum is developmentally based and has proven to be interactive and engaging. Our preschool program is an organization of St. Anne Catholic Church and is administered under the guidelines of the Church.

Confidentiality

Administration, teachers, and staff will maintain confidentiality regarding information entrusted to them, so long as no one's life, health, or safety is at stake.

*A registration fee is required at registration time and is an annual fee. This fee is due upon acceptance to the program and is non-refundable.

Tuition

➤ Two days per week

Total cost of **\$2,520** or 9 installments @ **\$280** per child per month

* \$100 discount will apply if paid in full first month.

Three days per week

Total cost of **\$3,600** or 9 installments @ **\$400** per child per month

* \$100 discount will apply if paid in full first month.

- August tuition is due the first day of school.

- Tuition is due by the 20th of each month.

Tuition may be paid by check or through the Brightwheel app.

A late fee of **\$20 per child** will be added to tuition fees if not paid in full by the **27th** of the month. A \$35 fee is charged for NSF checks. More than two NSF checks will require tuition to be paid by cash or money order only.

Withdrawal notice from our program should be given 2 weeks in advance so children on the waiting list can be notified in a timely fashion. You are responsible for any tuition unpaid. No tuition refunds are given if your child leaves the program.

Tuition will not be reimbursed for sickness, inclement weather, and unforeseen emergencies of any kind. Please notify the director or teacher via the Brightwheel app if your child will be absent from school. Please notify us of any contagious illness your child may contract.

POTTY TRAINING

As a team, we will work to train your two-year-old child when they are ready. Children are required to bring diapers (rather than Pull-Ups) if they are not yet fully trained. Over the years, staff has found this to be the most efficient. **ALL CHILDREN IN THREE- AND FOUR-YEAR-OLD CLASSES MUST BE FULLY TRAINED PRIOR TO ATTENDING.**

SCHOOL CLOSURES

We will observe the same early dismissal or closure as Lafayette Parish Schools. Should bad weather be experienced or any unforeseen emergencies arise, you will be notified. These public school announcements are made on the news, radio, & social media. You will also receive a Brightwheel notification from the preschool director or classroom teacher.

***Any closures due to bad weather or any unforeseen emergency will not be made up or credited to your tuition.**

DISCIPLINE

At St. Anne Preschool, we use a loving and positive approach to discipline. Good behavior will always be rewarded with kind words and praise. Behavior sometimes requires that a child be removed from the group activities. It may be necessary to notify the parent if help is needed to correct behavior that is inappropriate. We have the right to withdraw a child from our program who demonstrates continued inappropriate behavior or strong aggressive behavior. The safety of our staff and children is our first concern. Any remaining monthly tuition is not reimbursed in this case.

DRESS CODE

To assist with independence, please dress your child in clothing easily manipulated by your child. Help us minimize injuries by having your children wear shoes that are appropriate for playing and running. We appreciate your cooperation on this safety issue. Girls must wear shorts under dresses and skirts. No one-piece outfits. A complete change of clothes placed in a large Ziploc bag is required and will be used when needed. Please be sure to send ample diapers if applicable. Children who are three or older need to have an extra pair of undies included in their Ziploc. **Please remember to put your child's name on all personal items sent to St. Anne Preschool.**

HEALTH REGULATIONS

Children with illness should not be mixed with others. **To protect the health of our preschool, any child experiencing the following symptoms within 24 hours of attending school must remain home.** Please make the staff aware of such issues.

Symptoms include:

1. Temperature over 99 degrees without meds
2. Upset stomach, nausea and/or diarrhea
3. Nasal or eye discharge (yellow or greenish in color or crusted eye) which indicates infection
4. Sore throat or consistent cough or croup
5. Undiagnosed rash or bumps

If a child becomes ill or injured, parents will be asked to pick up the child at the time the phone call is made. Our staff does not administer medications except in extreme cases, e.g., related to possible allergic reactions. If your child needs medication during school hours, a parent may come to St. Anne Preschool to administer the medication. Students with requirements for inhalers, EpiPen, or other additional medical aids must coordinate their positioning and use with Administration

Please be sure that a minimum of two emergency numbers has been given to the office in addition to parent numbers and work numbers. It is necessary that the emergency contacts be based in Lafayette and can be readily available. No student will be released to anyone not appearing on the approved list without express permission from the parent/guardian.

A current copy of your child's immunization record is required, if one is not on file already. If the immunization record is not on file, then a parent must sign a Statement of Exemption from Immunizations form by the first day of school.

It is always important to make your child's teacher aware of any medicines your child is taking at all times, as this could impact their mood and behavior.

Please inform school officials and your child's teacher of any health problems or allergies that your child may have. As with any illness or medical emergency, St. Anne Preschool will act in the best interest of the child, taking into consideration their specific circumstances. Should the situation deem necessary, 911 will be called. An Administration of Medication Form will be completed and signed for a student who has a condition that may require medication in an urgent, as-needed situation.

****When your child is ill or will be absent for any reason, please text the teacher on the Brightwheel app about the absence.**

No pacifiers are allowed at school and not in backpacks!

MORNING DROP-OFF

Parents are asked to pull into the new church parking lot from Church Street, drive around and behind church to the driveway between the church and cemetery. Wait for a staff member to unload and greet your child, then continue on to exit into the street. Please use all safety precautions; be mindful of church parishioners and guests who may also be using the parking lot. DO NOT LEAVE children unattended.

Drop-off begins at 8:50. A teacher will unload your child from the passenger side. Please do not walk your child inside. It is our job to ensure that your child feels comfortable and safe in their new environment. Experience from years past has proven that the best approach for parents to take when dropping off their child is to reassure him/her you will be back later to pick them up and let the teacher comfort them. We know it is difficult to leave when your child is upset; you can call anytime to check on them. Do take comfort that we will call you if your child remains upset for a long period of time. All parent cooperation is greatly appreciated in this matter.

*Please tell any family members or friends who transport your child(ren) to school about our car line procedures.

PICKUP AND PARKING

Pickup begins at 1:45. For safety reasons, we require a written permission slip or phone call if anyone other than names listed on registration form is picking up your child. Please pick up your child by 2:00. Late fees will be charged after the 2nd notice. **A late fee of \$20 for the first 10 min and \$5 per every 5 min after that (per child)** will be assessed. This excludes emergencies of which we have been notified.

******NO PICKUP is allowed during quiet/naptime hours. (12:00-1:30pm)**

If you have appointments, please arrange to pick up the child either before or after naptime. This will prevent any distractions or disruptions to the class during this time. Thanks for your cooperation. If an emergency arises and pickup is necessary during this time frame, please contact the director.

Parents- Always keep us informed of any changes of any home, work, or cell phone numbers. In case of sickness or an emergency while your child is in the care of our preschool, we may need to call promptly.

SNACK

A snack will be provided for your child daily. Please make sure all allergy information is updated. Only water is allowed at St. Anne Preschool for snacks or lunch.

LUNCH

Children are required to bring lunch each day. Parents are responsible for the food preparation and safe temperature storage of their child's lunch. We will not be able to heat lunches. As our goal is always to foster independence and making good choices, please keep this in mind when deciding what to send with your child. **All food sensitivity & allergies must be documented.**

PHOTOS

We take photographs periodically of all children in our program and send to parents. Some photos/images are also occasionally placed on the church secured website at (www.stannechurch.net) and the St. Anne Facebook page. You may opt out of these postings via our Photo Release form. We will do our best to honor this request; however, we cannot guarantee that your child will never appear in an image, as instances may occur where it is unavoidable. Some examples of these instances may include: parents creating images and posting on social media sites, and crowd or background appearances.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

The Diocese of Lafayette, under mandate from the Bishop, requires parents and other volunteers who have any contact with minors be trained in the Diocese's Safe Environment Program (Virtus). All parents should contact the church's Safe Environment Coordinator for information on the in-person initial training and Virtus recertification. Employees must go through the same training in addition to undergoing an FBI criminal history check.

VISITORS ON CAMPUS AND STUDENT SAFETY

The welfare and safety of our students is a primary concern of every staff member. In order to ensure student safety, all persons coming onto the campus are to enter the building through the main entrance after ringing the doorbell. If a staff member does not recognize the visitor, that person may be asked to go to the church office first, and receive clearance from the reception office. Teachers and staff may not release students to anyone who is not on the list provided by parents.
